So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17 KJV

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

John 14:12-14 KJV

Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever ye desire**, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. **Mark 11:24 KJV**

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. **John 15:7 KJV**

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: and the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. **James 5:14-15 KJV**

If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and **prepared unto every good work.** **2 Timothy 2:21 KJV**

That the man of God may be perfect, throughly **furnished unto all good works.** **2 Timothy 3:17 KJV**

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, **may abound to every good work:** **2 Corinthians 9:8 KJV**

A sick person cannot measure up to these scriptures. These conditions would be impossible if healing is not for all. Either healing is for all, or the scriptures do not apply to all. Bodily healing in the New Testament was called a mercy,

and it was God's mercy which always moved Him to heal all the sick. His promise is that He is "plenteous in mercy to all that call on Him".

For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; And **plenteous in mercy** unto all them that call upon thee." **Psalm 86:5 KJV**

"For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. **2 Corinthians 5:21 KJV**

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.**1 Peter 2:24 KJV**

Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: **Galatians 3:13 KJV**

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: **Romans 8:3 KJV**

His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; (for he that is hanged is accursed of God;) that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance. **Deuteronomy 21:23 KJV**

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. **Matthew 8:17 KJV**
