Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. **Isaiah 53:4 NKJV**

Griefs is Hebrew word Choli which means "physical disease and Sicknesses". Sorrows is Hebrew word Makob which means "physical pain".

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses. **Matthew 8:17 NKJV**

Our spirits are not sick, they're dead. Our spirits aren't healed, they are recreated or regenerated.

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. **Isaiah 53:5 NKJV**

Transgression deals with Spirit. Iniquities deal with Soul. Striped deals with Flesh.

For I am poor and needy, And my heart is wounded within me. **Psalms** 109:22 NKJV

Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, **Psalms 103:1-3 NKJV**

Just as many were astonished at you, So His visage was marred more than any man, And His form more than the sons of men; **Isaiah 52:14 NKJV**

Who being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. **Philippians 2:6-7 NKJV**

But I am a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people. **Psalms 22:6 NKJV**

Adam is the first man. Dam means "blood". None of the blood of Jesus came from Mary, because it would have been contaminated.

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. **III John 1:2 NKJV**

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. **John 10:10 NKJV**

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. **James 5:14-15 NKJV**

For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep. I Corinthians 11:30 NKJV

For he who eats and drinks in an unworthily, manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. I Corinthians 11:29 NKJV

Unworthy is an adverb. What does an adverb do? It changes everything except Nouns.

But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world. **1 Corinthians 11:32 NKJV**

Condemned is catacrema in Greek.

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. **Romans 8:1 NKJV**

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), **Galatians**3:13 NKJV

And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. **Matthew 26:26-28 NKJV**

Blessed is Greek word Eulogeo means "Logos". This means to speak well of. Gave thanks in Greek Eucharisteo means "to be thankful through Grace".

As it is written, ("I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; **Romans 4:17 NKJV**

God said, "call those things not as though they are. He didn't call those things that are as though they are not".
