However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities.

And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases, **Luke 6:17 NKJV**

“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.” **John 14:12 NKJV**

“Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.” **John 14:10 NKJV**

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. **Acts 10:38 NKJV**

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. **Philippians 2:5-7 NKJV**

He only did miracles after He was anointed by the Holy Spirit.

For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure. **John 3:34 NKJV**

Jesus ministered on earth primarily as a prophet of the Old Covenant anointed by the Holy Spirit. You remember that He called Himself a prophet.

Then He said, "Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country." **Luke 4:24 NKJV**

Jesus stood in the fivefold ministry gifts: apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher.

### **(1) Apostle**

"Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus," **Hebrews 3:1 NKJV**

### **(2) Prophet**

Then He said, "Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country." **Luke 4:24 NKJV**

### **(3) Evangelist**

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;" **Luke 4:18 NKJV**

### **(4) Pastor**

And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away. **I Peter 5:4 NKJV**

### **(5) Teacher**

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. **Matthew 9:35 NKJV**

Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. **Mark 6:5 NKJV**

For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.
