Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. **Isaiah 53:4-5 NKJV**

Griefs is Kholee means "diseases. Sorrows is Makov means "pains".

Surely our sicknesses he hath borne, And our pains — he hath carried them, And we — we have esteemed him plagued, Smitten of God, and afflicted. Isaiah 53:4 YLT98

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses. **Matthew 8:17 NKJV**

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demonpossessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, **Matthew 8:16 NKJV**

He didn't heal everyone in Israel, but everyone who came to Him. Bible interprets Bible.

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. **Isaiah 53:5 NKJV**

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was crushed for our wickedness [our sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing]; The punishment [required] for our well-being fell on Him, And by His stripes (wounds) we are healed. **Isaiah 53:5 AMP**

Well Being is the Greek word "Shalom".

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. **I Peter 2:24 NKJV**

TJ McCrossan a Greek Scholar said. If Jesus was beaten the stripes one His back left Slavs of Flesh the word in the Greek should be plural. But stripes in Greek is singular.

I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. **Psalms 22:17 NKJV**

There is no more skin left so the singular should be used by His stripe we are healed.

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. **Isaiah 53:5 NKJV**

Stripes is Hebrew Chavar means "stripe and wound". That not only deals with stripes on His back but fellowship association. Chavar means "fellowship".

The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? **I Corinthians 10:16 NKJV**

Communion means "fellowship, association, intimate participation". In Hebrew the word communion means "Chavar" same word as stripes.

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. **Isaiah 53:5 NKJV**

God says that it is by fellowshipping with those stripes. This is how fellowship with the body of Christ.
