Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained <u>eternal redemption</u>. **Hebrews 9:12 NKJV**

And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the **eternal inheritance**. **Hebrews 9:15 NKJV**

For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another— He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation. **Hebrews 9:24-28 NKJV**

For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had **no more consciousness of sins.** Hebrews 10:1-2 NKJV

But in those sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins. Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. **Hebrews 10:3-5 NKJV**

Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. Then I said, "Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me." **Psalms 40:6-7 NKJV**

In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. Hebrews 10:6 NKJV

Then I said, 'Behold, I have come— In the volume of the book it is written of Me— To do Your will, O God.' **Hebrews 10:7 NKJV**

Previously saying, "Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them" (which are offered according to the law), then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second." **Hebrews 10:8-9 NKJV**

By that will we **have been sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. **Hebrews 10:10 NKJV**

Five times **once** is used in **Hebrews chapter 9 and 10**. Once means " Upon one occasion only".

So Christ was offered <u>once</u> to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation. **Hebrews 9:28 NKJV**

For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, <u>once</u> purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins. **Hebrews 10:2 NKJV**

By that will we **have been sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. **Hebrews 10:10 NKJV**

Jesus rose from the dead to enforce His own will.

And o every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But this Man, after He had offered **one sacrifice for sins forever**, sat down at the right hand of God, **Hebrews 10:11-12 NKJV**

From that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool. For by one offering He has **perfected forever** those who are **being sanctified**. **Hebrews 10:13-14 NKJV**

By that will we **have been sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. **Hebrews 10:10 NKJV**

This is talking about the spirit of a man. Sanctified means "to be set apart unto God".

To the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of **just men made perfect**. **Hebrews 12:23 NKJV**

And that you put on the <u>new man</u> which <u>was created according to God, in</u> <u>true righteousness and holiness</u>. Ephesians 4:24 NKJV

In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were **<u>sealed with the Holy</u>** <u>**Spirit**</u> of promise, **Ephesians 1:13 NKJV**

<u>God is Spirit</u>, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth. John 4:24 NKJV
