Sanctification and Holiness are the same Greek word. Holy because I am is Holy.

For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect. **Hebrews 10:1 KJV**

FOR SINCE the Law has merely a rude outline (foreshadowing) of the good things to come-instead of fully expressing those things-it can never by offering the same sacrifices continually year after year make perfect those who approach [its altars]. **Hebrews 10:1 AMPC**

Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience; **Hebrews 9:9 KJV**

For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins. **Hebrews 10:2 KJV**

But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. **Hebrews 10:3-4 KJV**

Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: **Hebrews 10:5 KJV**

In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure. Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God. Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law; **Hebrews 10:6-8 KJV**

Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second. **Hebrews 10:9 KJV**

He then went on to say, Behold, [here] I am, coming to do Your will. Thus He does away with and annuls the first (former) order [as a means of expiating sin] so that He might inaugurate and establish the second (latter) order.

Hebrews 10:9 AMPC

The first order was blood of bulls and goats as an atonement. We are going to do away with the first order.

By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. **Hebrews 10:10 KJV**

But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: **1 Corinthians 1:30 KJV**

And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: **Hebrews 10:11 KJV**

But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. **Hebrews 10:12-14 KJV**

For by a single offering He has forever completely cleansed and perfected those who are consecrated and made holy. **Hebrews 10:14 AMPC**

Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. **Hebrews** 9:12 KJV

Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before, This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; **Hebrews 10:15-16 KJV**

And also the Holy Spirit adds His testimony to us [in confirmation of this]. For having said, This is the agreement (testament, covenant) that I will set up and

conclude with them after those days, says the Lord: I will imprint My laws upon their hearts, and I will inscribe them on their minds (on their inmost thoughts and understanding), **Hebrews 10:15-16 AMPC**

And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. **Hebrews 10:17 KJV**

Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; **Hebrews 10:18-20 KJV**

Be alright with who you are in Christ.

And since we have [such] a great and wonderful and noble Priest [Who rules] over the house of God, Let us all come forward and draw near with true (honest and sincere) hearts in unqualified assurance and absolute conviction engendered by faith (by that leaning of the entire human personality on God in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness), having our hearts sprinkled and purified from a guilty (evil) conscience and our bodies cleansed with pure water. **Hebrews 10:21-22 AMPC**

Evil means "Sin Consciousness".

So let us seize and hold fast and retain without wavering the hope we cherish and confess and our acknowledgement of it, for He Who promised is reliable (sure) and faithful to His word. **Hebrews 10:23 AMPC**

Reliable, sure, faithful to His word.

And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: **Hebrews 10:24 KJV**

And let us consider and give attentive, continuous care to watching over one another, studying how we may stir up (stimulate and incite) to love and helpful deeds and noble activities, **Hebrews 10:24 AMPC**

Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. **Hebrews 10:25 KJV**
