Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned— **(Romans 5:12 NKJV)**

And the gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned. For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification. For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life." **(Romans 5:16-18 NKJV)**

Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. **(Psalms 103:2-5 NKJV)**

He forgave your sin first and sickness is a byproduct of sin. If you deal with root which is sickness (sin), you can deal with fruit. The moment you are forgiven your sickness is gone.

Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, "Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone? But immediately,

when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, “Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, ‘Your sins are forgiven you,’ or to say, ‘Arise, take up your bed and walk?’” **(Mark 2:2-9 NKJV)**

“But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins”—He said to the paralytic, “I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” **(Mark 2:10-11 NKJV)**

And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world. **(I John 2:2 NKJV)**

If you are forgiven, sickness has no legal right to be in your body.

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. **(Matthew 14:14 NKJV)**

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. **(Acts 10:38 NKJV)**

Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give. **(Matthew 10:8 NKJV)**

So that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed. **(Acts 5:15-16 NKJV)**

To another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, **(I Corinthians 12:9 NKJV)**

So that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, **(I Corinthians 1:7 NKJV)**

They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover. **(Mark 16:18 NKJV)**

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. **(James 5:14-16 NKJV)**
