And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.
Exodus 25:8 NKJV

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. **John 1:14 NKJV**

The tabernacle is Jesus and that is where God and Man meet.

For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. **Hebrews 4:15 NKJV**

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham. Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. **Hebrews 2:14-17 NKJV**

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." **John 14:6 NKJV**

Jesus lives in a three room house. In the living room is a love seat.

Whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, **Romans 3:25 NKJV**

But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves. **Malachi 4:2 NKJV**

In Exodus 25 to Exodus 40, He describes the ark of the covenant from the inside (God) out. This is a revelation of Grace. From the outer court(Man) is a walk of faith.

Have I not written to you excellent things Of counsels and knowledge, That I may make you know the certainty of the words of truth, That you may answer words of truth To those who send to you? **Proverbs 22:20-21 NKJV**

Excellent means “threefold”. Way, Truth, and Life. Passover, Pentecost and Tabernacle. 30, 60, and 100.

Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken. **Ecclesiastes 4:12 NKJV**

There were seven pieces of furniture in the tabernacle of Moses. In the court was the brazen altar and the laver.

But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. John 19:34 NKJV

At the laver we are washed with the water of the Word. The laver has no measurements.

For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure. **John 3:34 NKJV**

You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. **John 15:3 NKJV**

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, **Titus 3:5 NKJV**

In the holy place was Menorah, Altar of Incense, and Table of Showbread.

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, “I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.” **John 8:12 NKJV**

Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

Romans 8:34 NKJV

The Incense is a picture of prayers of God. The Alter of Incense is the highest piece of Furniture. This means that Intercession is the highest. Remember this inter-seed. An intercessor is standing between the living and the dead. He swallowed dead and hell and never contaminated.

Let my prayer be set before You as incense, The lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice. **Psalms 141:2 NKJV**

Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. **Revelation 5:8 NKJV**

Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. **Revelation 8:3 NKJV**

“I am the bread of life.” **John 6:48 NKJV**

In the Most Holy place was Ark of covenant and Mercy seat. This was in the Ark of Covenant two tablets of the Ten commandments, the Golden Pot of Manna, and Aaron’s rod that budded with life.

Whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, **Romans 3:25 NKJV**

Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. **Hebrews 9:12 NKJV**
