

The Blood is Eternal

Also for Adam and his wife the LORD God made tunics of skin, and clothed them. **Genesis 3:21 NKJV**

The animal sacrifice was given by God and Adam and Eve did nothing. The Hebrew word for coats signifies a complete covering from head to toe.

Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment, Who stretch out the heavens like a curtain. **Psalms 104:2 NKJV**

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! **(John 1:29 NKJV)**

Takes means "removing sin, doing away with guilt and punishment."

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. **(I Peter 2:24 NKJV)**

In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. **(Colossians 1:14 NKJV)**

Forgiveness in the Greek means "to send them away." Your sin has been sent away, to be remembered no more.

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace **(Ephesians 1:7 NKJV)**

Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, **(Romans 3:24, 25 NKJV)**

Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the

blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance. **(Hebrews 9:12-15 NKJV)**

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. **(1 John 1:7 NKJV)**

Cleanses in Greek means " a present continuous action". Once you are a believer, the blood of Jesus keeps on cleansing you from every sin.

For by a single offering He has forever completely cleansed and perfected those who are consecrated and made holy. **(Hebrews 10:14 AMPC)**

But if we [really] are living and walking in the Light, as He [Himself] is in the Light, we have [true, unbroken] fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses (removes) us from all sin and guilt [keeps us cleansed from sin in all its forms and manifestations]. **(1 John 1:7 AMPC)**

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. **(Romans 5:9 NKJV)**

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. **(Ephesians 2:13 NKJV)**

And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. **(Colossians 1:20 NKJV)**

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? **(Hebrews 9:14 NKJV)**

And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission. **(Hebrews 9:22 NKJV)**

For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.' **(Leviticus 17:11 NKJV)**

For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. **(Romans 10:3 NKJV)**

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." **(Romans 1:16, 17 NKJV)**

You didn't do anything to become righteous and Jesus didn't do anything to become sin.

It was to demonstrate and prove at the present time (in the now season) that He Himself is righteous and that He justifies and accepts as righteous him who has [true] faith in Jesus. **(Romans 3:26 AMP)**

There God declares that He Himself becomes the righteousness of the man who has faith in Jesus as a Savior and confesses Him as His Lord. No man can stand right with God simply by having his sins pardoned. It would leave the old nature that produced those sins still master of the situation.

He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. **(Hebrews 9:26 NKJV)**

End in the Greek means " the closing of one age and beginning of another one."

Here we get God's statement regarding sin. Man can become a new creation because his sin nature was laid on Jesus. When He was made sin and put sin away.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, **(II Corinthians 5:17, 18 NKJV)**

There is a perfect reconciliation. There could not be perfect reconciliation if there was sin in this New Creation. He has made a new being
